CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No. GJ/5/GAB/1080/(48)E.2.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the constitution of India, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Executive Engineer (civil) Gujarat Service of Engineers Class-I Recruitment Rules, 1979 prescribed under Government Notification, Public Works Department No. GAB-1173(13)/E.2, dated 29th March, 1979 as follows namely:—

1. These rules may be called the Executive Engineer (civil) in Gujarat Service of Engineers, Class-I Recruitment (amendment) Rules, 1981.

2. In the Executive Engineer (civil) Gujarat Service of Engineers Class-I, Recruitment Rules, 1979 in rule 5, the following shall be substituted, namely:—

“5 To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2 above, a candidate must—

(a) be not less than 21 years and not more than 28 years of age;

(b) Possess a degree in Bachelor of Engineering (civil) with atleast 60 percent of the total marks or B.E. (civil) with post graduate degree in M.E. (civil) of a recognised University with atleast 60 percent of the total marks or other equivalent qualification as recognised by the Government of Gujarat.

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Service Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967, as amended from time to time.”
