

These terms and conditions shall be applicable to those employees who are working on deputation by enbloc-transfer and those who are deputed by Govt. from time to time.

ANNEXURE

Detailed terms and conditions of deputation of all deputed Government Servants to the Sardar Sarovar Narmada Nigam Limited, Gandhinagar.

1. The period of deputation of all deputed Govt. Servants shall be for one year from the date of relief.
2. All deputed Government servants shall draw their pay in the pay scale of their own grade that they would have drawn while on duty in the department had they not been sent on deputation. The pay referred to above will be the pay as decided under Bombay Civil Services Rules 9(39)(a).
3. They will not be entitled to draw deputation allowance as Govt. of Gujarat has discontinued the benefit of deputation pay.
4. In case of promotion in the parent department but for their deputation they shall be allowed to get the pay fixed in accordance with the Bombay Civil Service Rule 56-A.
5. They shall be allowed to draw the personal pay if any that they would have drawn while on duty in parent department had they are not been sent on deputation.
6. They shall not be entitled to opt for the pay scale of the post of deputation.
7. They will be entitled to dearness allowance during the period of their deputation which they would have drawn had they not been sent on deputation.

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8. They shall be entitled to receive compensatory Local Allowance and House Rent Allowance admissible at place of duty while on deputation in accordance with the rules of the State Govt. or as per rules of Central Govt. at their option.

9. They will be entitled to transfer travelling allowance and joining time pay on joining the post on deputation as well as on reversion to State Govt. under the rules of the State Govt. or as per rules of the borrowing authority. The expenditure on this account will be borne by that authority.

10. During the period of deputation they shall be entitled to get travelling allowance at their option under the rules of the State Govt. or as per rules of the borrowing authority.

11. During the period of deputation they will continue to be governed by the leave, pension and Provident Fund Rules of the State Govt. as applicable to them from time to time.

12. They will be entitled to the leave travel concessions under the scheme of the State Govt. Finance Department, Govt. Resolution No. MSB-2166-1298-J dated the 15th Octo. 1966, as amended from time to time or as per the Rules of the borrowing authority at their option. The liability of such concessions during the deputation period shall be borne by the borrowing authority.

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13. They will be entitled to medical facilities according to Govt. Rules or at their option as per rules of the borrowing authority. The liability in this behalf shall be borne by the borrowing authority.

14. If unfurnished residential accommodation is provided by other Govt./ Companies/ Corpn. they shall have to pay the rent to other Govt./ Companies/ Corpn. etc. at the flat rate of prescribed under F.L. G.R. NO.ECR/1087/59/M dated 3-9-87. In case Govt. accommodation is allotted to them, the difference between flat rate prescribed under F.L. G.R. ECR/1087/59/M dated 3-9-87 and the economic rent that may be fixed for the accommodation allotted to them should be borne by Corporation.

15. In case they are provided with Govt. accommodation at Gandhinagar, they shall have to pay rent to the Sardar Sarovar Narmada Nigam Ltd., Gandhinagar at the rate prescribed in Govt. Resolution, F.L. NO. MIR-1170-36-Conf1. CH dated 16-4-1970 as amended from time to time.

16. The whole expenditure in respect of any compensatory allowance for the period of leave taken by deputationist on foreign service while in or at the end of the foreign service shall be borne by the borrowing authority.

17. The borrowing authority shall not promote deputationist to higher post/ grade/ pay scales etc. or grant new or increased allowance without the prior consent of the State Govt.

18. The deputation will commence from the date they are relieved by the State Govt. Duration of deputation will be counted from the date of relief from their post under the State Govt. upto the date of their taking over charge of their post under the State Govt.

19. The borrowing authority will be responsible for the payment of any gratuity or pension that may be admissible under the Bombay Civil Services Rules because of any injury sustained by them or their death occurred as a result of any injury sustained during the period of deputation.

20. The borrowing authority shall be liable to pay leave emoluments in respect of any disability incurred in and through deputation period under that authority even if such injury/ liability manifested itself after the termination of deputation period under that authority.

21. They shall be allowed to draw conveyance allowance, any other allowance for maintenance car or any other vehicles etc. as per rules of the State Govt. or as per rules of the borrowing authority at their option.

22. They shall be allowed to draw bonus/ ex-gratia payment in lieu of bonus that may be declared by the borrowing authority subject to the provisions of the payment of Bonus Act, 1965 and the orders issued by the Govt. from time to time.

23. In the matter of disciplinary action and the departmental inquiry they will be governed by the orders issued by the State Govt. from time to time.

24. In respect of matters relating to other conditions of service not specifically provided here, they will be governed by Bombay Civil Services Rules and other orders issued by the State Govt. as may be in force from time to time.

25. During the period of deputation, the Govt. Employee shall continue to be governed by the State Govt. Employees' Insurance Scheme as introduced under Govt. Resolution, F.L. No. APB-1081-31-Z dated the 10th November, 1981, or the scheme adopted under Govt. Resolution, F.L. No. ABP-1078-3999(79)-Z dated the 23rd Nov. 1979 in the case of Govt. Employee who opts for the old scheme, as the case may be.

26. While deputing them in the Dist. of their home town, the borrowing authority must follow the provisions continued in General Admn. Deptt. Circular No. TRF-1064-G dated 27-5-1964.

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
