

Subject—IRRIGATION AND POWER PROJECT-SUBMISSION AND EXAMINATION OF.

In partial modification of Planning Commission letter No. III-1(1)/65-I and P, dated July 25, 1966 on the above subject, the limit of Rs. two crores fixed for the estimated cost of irrigation projects for examination on a proforma basis indicated in paras 1(a) (i) 2, 3 and para 4 of the letter is hereby raised to Rs. three crores with immediate effect. As a result of the raising of this limit it has been considered that the proforma in respect of statement I, enclosure to the above mentioned letter, in which information will be required to be furnished by the State Governments in respect of Irrigation Projects costing Rs. 3 crores or less each may be amplified. The modified proforma as drawn up in consultation with the Ministry of Irrigation and Power is enclosed.

2. Projects costing between Rs. two crores and Rs. three crores for which project reports have already been received from State Government by Central Water and Power Commission and are under examination or which are received hereafter will now only be examined in the manner in which projects on proforma basis are examined viz., in respect of (a) basic planning and availability of water, (b) inter-state aspects and (e) any other important aspect radically affecting the size and shape of the project.

3. For schemes costing Rs. 3 crores or less each for which project reports have yet to be sent by the State Government, only the information in the enclosed revised proforma need be sent.
